#### **PLASTIC WATER BOTTLES**

#### **PET POLICY**

For health and safety reason, McLean Youth Soccer bans dogs from all games and practices regardless of their locations. The Fairfax County School Board has publicized a ban on dogs on all school fields and MYS extends this to events held at all of its facilities as well.

#### **TSL TRAINING**

Several years ago MYS added a new volunteer position, the Team Sideline Liaison (TSL). The purpose of this volunteer position is to improve everyone's (players, parents, coaches, and referees) game time experience by improving the behavior of fans on the sideline. Sideline behavior in MYS is better than most youth clubs but we still have too many problems. The TSL is "the voice of the child," as it is always the players that suffer from sideline behavior problems.

All travel teams are required to have a TSL but MYS's goal is to have a volunteer TSL from each house league team as well. This volunteer cannot be the coach or the coach's spouse. The only requirement for the TSL is to go to one training session, which will be provided by MYS. These sessions are run by an experienced and widely respected Certified Sports Psychologist, Neal Bowes, of "SIMPLYaphilosophy" who has not only theoretical knowledge but a broad background in youth soccer.

The last training session for the spring season is this Thursday, April 24 from 7 to 9 PM at McLean High School in the Lecture Hall--Room #187.
